Boys Dress Code (Grades R to 7):

- **Shoes:** Black school shoes, well-polished, and suitable for the school environment. Closed-toe shoes that are properly maintained.
- **Shirt:** A white shirt with a school badge on the shirt pocket. Ensure the shirt is clean, wellironed, and fits properly. Badges can be purchased from the school and should be affixed to the shirt pocket according to school guidelines.
- **Trousers:** Grey pants that are well-fitted, clean, and fitted at the waist.
- **Belt:** A black belt that complements the uniform. It should be properly sized and in good condition.
- **Tie:** A navy blue tie is mandatory for students in grades 4 to 7. The tie should be worn according to school guidelines.
- **Blazer:** A navy blue blazer is compulsory for students in grades 4 to 7. The blazer should fit well and be adorned with the school badge, which can be purchased from the school.
- **Socks:** Grey school socks in compliance with the uniform code.
- **Physical Education Clothing:** The specified Ariston PE t-shirt which can be bought at the school, white PE shorts, white socks, and plain white or navy blue takkies (sneakers) without markings, patterns, or different colours. Ensure the Ariston PE t-shirt and white PE shorts are worn during Physical Education classes. A navy blue windbreaker can be worn with the PE clothing.
- Jewellery: Boys may not wear any jewellery, only an analogue wristwatch and no earrings will be allowed.
- **Tracksuits:** Tracksuits are available at the school and may be worn on PE days and days stipulated by the school administration.
- **Hair:** Boys hair should be short top, back and sides, no lines or patterns will be allowed. NB:// YOU CANNOT COMBINE PE CLOTHING WITH SCHOOL UNIFORM.

Girls Dress Code (Grades R to 7):

- **Shoes:** Black school shoes, polished, and appropriate for the school environment. Closed-toe shoes that are well-maintained.
- **Shirt:** A white shirt with a school badge on the shirt pocket. Ensure the shirt is clean, wellironed, and fits properly. Badges can be purchased from the school and should be affixed to the shirt pocket according to school guidelines.
- **Tie:** A navy blue tie is compulsory for girls in grades 4 to 7. The tie should be worn according to school guidelines.
- **Blazer:** A navy blue blazer is compulsory for girls in grades 4 to 7. The blazer should fit well and have a school badge affixed to the pocket, which can be obtained from the school.
- **Skirt:** Navy skirt/gym that is precisely 3cm above the knee line. The skirt should be well-fitted, clean, and adhere to the school's uniform policy regarding length and fitted at the waist.
- **Socks or Pantihose:** Girls may wear either white ankle socks with their school shoes or opt for navy pantihose, following the school's uniform policy.
- **Hair Accessories:** Hair should always be tied up out of your face and properly accessorized with white or navy-blue hair ties only, as required by the school. No beads and different colour streaks.
- **Earrings and Jewellery:** Only stud earrings are allowed. Hoop earrings and other jewellery items are not permitted. An analogue wristwatch is the only allowable accessory in terms of jewellery.
- **Physical Education Clothing:** The specified Ariston PE t-shirt which can be bought at the school, white PE shorts, white socks, and plain white or navy blue takkies (sneakers) without markings, patterns, or different colours. Ensure the Ariston PE t-shirt and white PE shorts are worn during Physical Education classes. A navy blue windbreaker can be worn with the PE clothing.
- **Tracksuits:** Tracksuits are available at the school and may be worn on PE days and days stipulated by the school administration.
